

David and Wendy write an excellent account of their trip from the Bahamas to the Dominican Republic. As a kid, I lived on Rum Cay for a few months while our yacht was anchored off the beach. We went through a few storms as described in this book. My sense is that if the story he tells matches the experiences we had, he must be writing what he sees with interest and accuracy. The beat to the Caribbean from the Bahamas is brutal. They write of it in terms that make one sense that it is tough and worth it.An impressive story. The tale of Custom in Provenciales, T&C is classic. I don't doubt a word of it is fiction. Next up is their book about the Caribbean where I have spent many years sailing. Can't wait to compare experiences.
