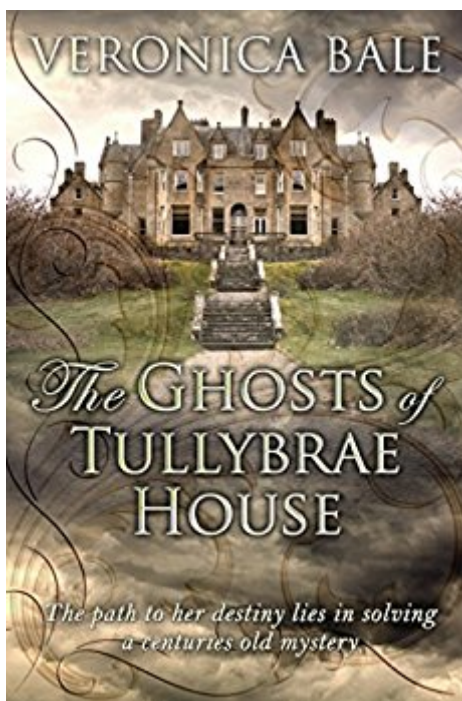

I've always enjoyed Veronica Bale's books, so when this new book came up I was intrigued. I'm so

very glad that I pursued it. What a great book! I could not put it down. A great mystery with wonderful characters that was beautifully written. I had no problem imagining everything that was being described through the written word. I don't want to give anything away here but there are so many ways to describe this book: a great mystery, a puzzle that demands to be solved, a tale of fate and destiny, a unique romance, a bit of Scotland's history with a paranormal twist. Two lost souls, separated by time, that fate brought together. And the end? Sigh worthy! I thoroughly enjoyed this book. It was a great read!

I've never read a love story quite like this one. It's a unique story line. The author does a great job of telling the story from the present while seamlessly transitioning to and from the past with breathtaking description. This may be the first time I've ever read a book that left me wanting to visit the setting of the story. I hadn't thought much about seeing Scotland before, but the descriptions are so beautiful that it's now on my to-see list. The characters are also very well written with distinct and likable personalities. The love story between Emmie and Cael is lovely and gut-wrenching at times. Emmie has some extremely difficult choices to make at every turn. All along, you can feel how strongly Cael wants her and needs her. I had a few guesses as to how the story might end, but I was completely surprised at what actually happened. All in all, a great read!

With the exception of a few typos this book is one of the best I've read in a long time. You laugh, cry and "oh my" with Emmie. I loved the vivid descriptions of the area and house. Funny how Cael doesn't have to say a word to get his message across. Loved Mrs Lamb, yes really! I encourage you to read this book.

This was my first time reading this author. A friend recommended this book. When I first started to read it, I had decided to give up on it, before I got very much further. But for some reason, I continued. The reason why, for about the first 50% of the book, it explains why Emmie has arrived at Tullybrae house and her job there. But then it gets repetitive about EVERYTHING. It describes her clothing, what she wears, what she pairs with it, her jewelry selection, over and over. Then it describes what she does in the bathroom, how she fixes her hair, etc. etc. Then we are told about breakfast and dinner, what she eats and how it tastes, etc. etc. We are told a little about the house and its objects, antiques, etc. By this point I am sick of hearing about her wardrobe and skipping parts of every description. But by 50%, we are getting to the meat of the story. (I absolutely adore Lamb) I was very surprised by this story when it finally got down to telling it. I actually felt the sadness

and despair she was going thru, and the frustration she was having when it came to Cael. But he is not the only ghost in the house, so I won't give details to spoil it. By this time, I really didn't want to put it down. In a way, the author kinda re-writes history, (so not sure about the repercussions of that) I was also very sad at the way that Cael was treated by his family. And at times, I really wanted to smack Emmie for being so wishy-washie. But overall, once you get by the repetitive descriptions, it is a very heart warming story. I am so glad that it ended the way it did. So yes, maybe I would give this author another try. I especially love the portrayal of the ghosts in this story.

I chose this book because I am an avid reader / film watcher of historical fiction that deals with Scotland. Couldn't put it down till I reached the end. My interest was piqued from the beginning. Ms Vale has the gift of taking you to whatever time in history she is writing about and making you a part of it as though you were there. I highly recommend it .

The story line was a good premise and an enjoyable read. The character development was very good, though there were a few questions left unanswered about supporting characters. The book needed a bit of proofreading, particularly in the second half. But overall, I really enjoyed the story and the read and would by this author again

Emmie and Cael are an interesting pair and their happy ever after is a lovely twist. The butler, Lamb, and his mother are so much fun, and the history, mystery and romance of it are a delight when we finally get to it. It did seem, though, that the book was too long. It could have gotten to the point much faster had the beginning been less about the descriptions of everything (over and over again), and more about the story/relationships/ghosts (yes, ghosts, plural!). Hang in there, though, because there is a story there that is worth the time.

This was a very good book. It has everything you want in a good mystery. There is love, betrayal, mystery, and time travel. I literally could not put the book down. This is a real page Turner. The main character, Emmie gets her world turned upside down and inside out. Buy the book. You will not regret it!
